<u>Entries:</u>	All entries are to be submitted via the attached entry form. Entries close on Wednesday, 12 th June 2024. Students must be under the age of 19 years as at 1 st January 2024 and fulfill the eligibility criteria for competition in secondary school sports as defined by the Schoolsport New Zealand.
<u>Entry Fee:</u>	\$80.00 (GST inclusive) per team with the school being invoiced prior to the event.

<u>Manager's Meeting:</u>	Saturday - 22 nd June @ 9.00 am at the Otago Squash Club. Each school MUST have a Team Manager present. Please provide Manager's name and contact details on entry form
<u>Draws:</u>	Will be distributed once entries are received. Will also be posted on Squash Otago website – www.squashotago.co.nz
<u>Eyewear:</u>	Compulsory
<u>Prize-giving:</u>	Presentations for all grades will be held at the completion of the last round of matches on Sunday
<u>Refereeing:</u>	A tournament referee and disputes committee will be in attendance.
<u>Food:</u>	Light food and non-alcoholic drinks will be available for purchase at the venue during the tournament. There are a number of food outlets e.g. Subway, KFC, Dominios within walking district of the courts (across the road)
<u>Accommodation:</u>	Please contact Aynsley aynsley@squashotago.co.nz if you require information on suitable accommodation

Tournament Information:

- Teams will consist of 3 players (reserves can be added but seedings will be based on top 3 players)
- Where possible, boys and girls will play separate competitions
- Schools may enter more than one team
- Draw format will be dependent on the number of teams entered
- Players must play in order according to Squash Levels
- All players MUST wear protective eyewear - and are expected to provide their own
- Each tie consists of 3 matches (1 match per player)
- Each match is the best of 5 games – PAR scoring to 15 win by 2
- Playing order – 3, 1, 2
- Games to be self-umpired by teams – 2, 3, 1
- Players are to arrive at the courts at least 15 minutes prior to their playing time
- Balls – B grade and above – Dunlop Double Yellow; C1 and below- Dunlop single yellow unless BOTH players agree otherwise. Blue dots will be available for use
- All games of graded players will count for levels points
