Tournament Information:

- Teams will consist of 3 players (reserves can be added but seedings will be based on top 3 players)
- Where possible, boys and girls will play separate competitions
- Schools may enter more than one team
- Draw format will be dependent on the number of teams entered
- Players must play in order according to Squash Levels
- All players MUST wear protective eyewear and are expected to provide their own
- Each tie consists of 3 matches (1 match per player)
- Each match is the best of 5 games PAR scoring to 15 win by 2
- Playing order 3, 1, 2
- Games to be self-umpired by teams 2, 3, 1
- Players are to arrive at the courts at least 15 minutes prior to their playing time
- Balls B grade and above Dunlop Double Yellow; C1 and below- Dunlop single yellow unless BOTH players agree otherwise. Blue dots will be available for use
- All games of graded players will count for levels points
